Required Documentation for Coverage Continuation

Dependent Child, from age 22 up to age 25, who is a Full-Time Student

Described below is the documentation that will be accepted as proof of eligibility for continuation of coverage for a dependent child, from age 22 to age 25, who is a full-time student of an accredited college/university. Please do not send original documents. Copies of the documents are acceptable.

You **must** supply official accredited college/university/institution documentation that indicates full-time student status for the most recent semester/term. All documents must include the following pre-printed information:

- Name of the accredited school
- Name of the dependent
- Semester/quarter/term in which the student is enrolled
- Total number of credit hours with indication of full-time status

If you are covering a stepchild and your spouse or domestic partner is not a covered dependent, you must also provide documentation of your current relationship to your spouse or domestic partner (marriage certificate, domestic partner declaration form or most recent filed 1040 Federal Tax Return showing relationship status).

If **proof of relationship** for a dependent child is requested, either of the following forms of documentation is acceptable:

- Preferred Documentation – Child's Birth/Adoption Certificate or court order of legal guardianship (not temporary for less than 12 months)

OR

- Alternate Documentation – Front page of most recent filed 1040 Federal Tax Return with dependent listed (black out all financial information)
